Green Technology Alumni's Gold Medal Department of Agricultural Engineering and Environmental Technology, Faculty of Agriculture, University of Ruhuna

Green Technology Alumni's Gold Medal shall be awarded annually to the student with the best overall performance who follows BSc. Honour in Green Technology. This Medal is funded by the Alumni of Green Technology. A student shall be selected under the approved marking scheme.

A Gold Medal and a Certificate of Achievement shall be awarded. Students of graduating batch will be eligible for the Green Technology Alumni's Gold Medal. The Gold Medal and the certificate of achievement will be awarded at the General Convocation.

At the end of the degree program faculty will display the list of graduates who are eligible for the gold medal. Interested candidates should apply for the gold medal during the stipulated period.

1. Application Procedure

- Students shall apply for the awards using the application issued by the Faculty of Agriculture, University of Ruhuna. Application forms shall be available at the Dean's office of the Faculty of Agriculture and can be downloaded from the Website of the Department of Agricultural Engineering and Environmental Technology.
- Students shall submit certified copies of all the documentary evidence with the application.
- Students shall submit their applications through the Head of the Department of Agricultural Engineering and Environmental Technology who shall certify the contents of the applications.
- Students shall prepare and participate in an interview if the selection panel requests.

2. Eligibility requirements

2.1. Academic

Requirements

The students obtaining an Overall Grade Point Average with a Second-Class Upper Division or above for the Degree of Bachelor of Science Honours in Green Technology will be eligible for a Medal.

2.2. Other Requirements

- Any student who has been punished by the University and/or warned (in writing) by the Vice Chancellor, Deputy Vice-Chancellor or Dean as found guilty of any misconduct shall not be eligible for an award.
- The overall score achieved by the applicant shall be 60 marks or above for the Medal.
- The student with highest marks shall be awarded the Gold Medal.

3. Selection Criteria

3.1. Academic Achievements (Maximum 50 marks)

The first class with OGPA 4.0 shall be given 50 marks. If there is no applicant having the highest OGPA (4.0), the other eligible students shall be given marks which are scaled down according to their OGPA given in the table. The OGPA obtained for all examinations shall be considered for the Medal.
